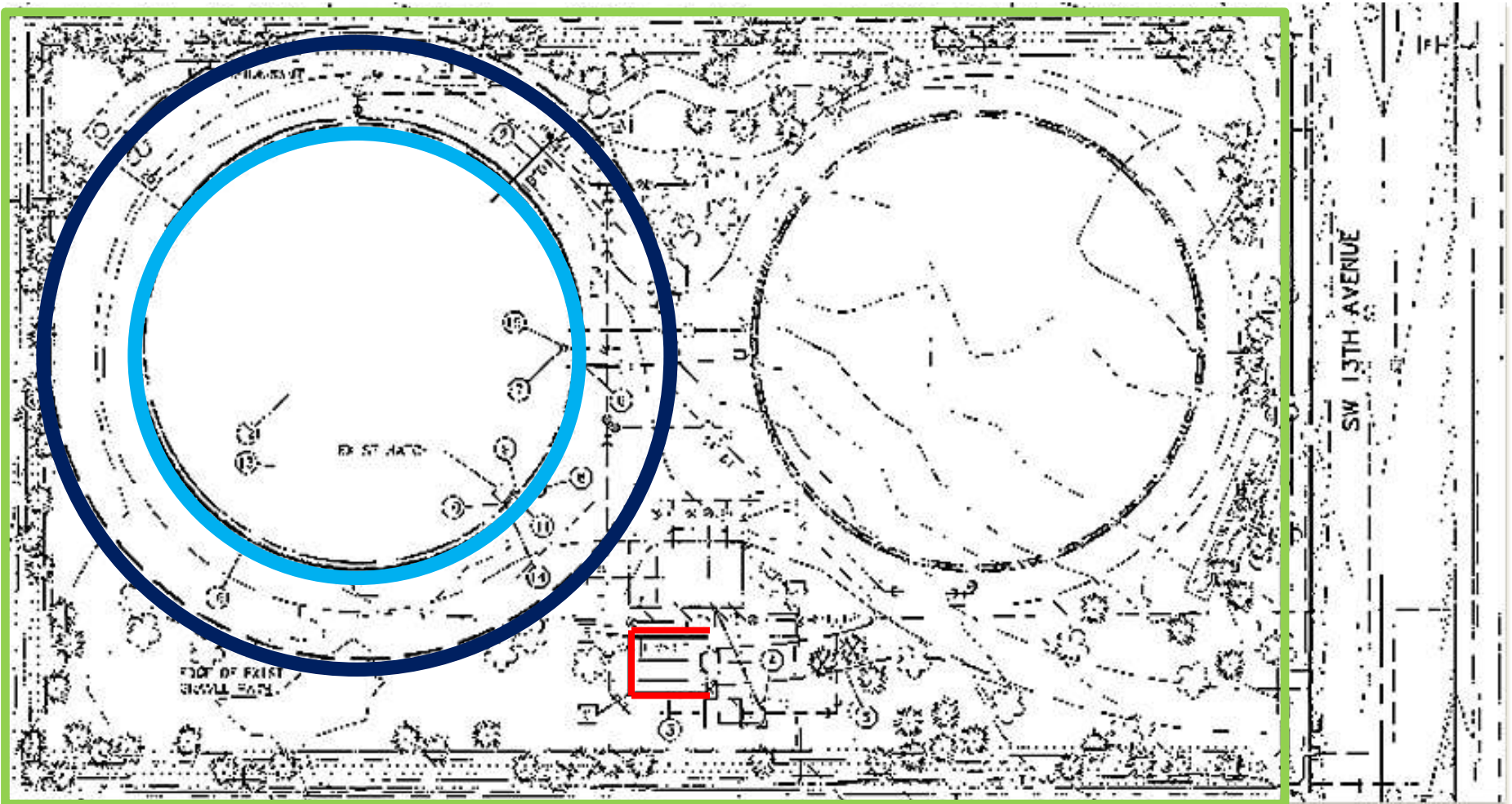

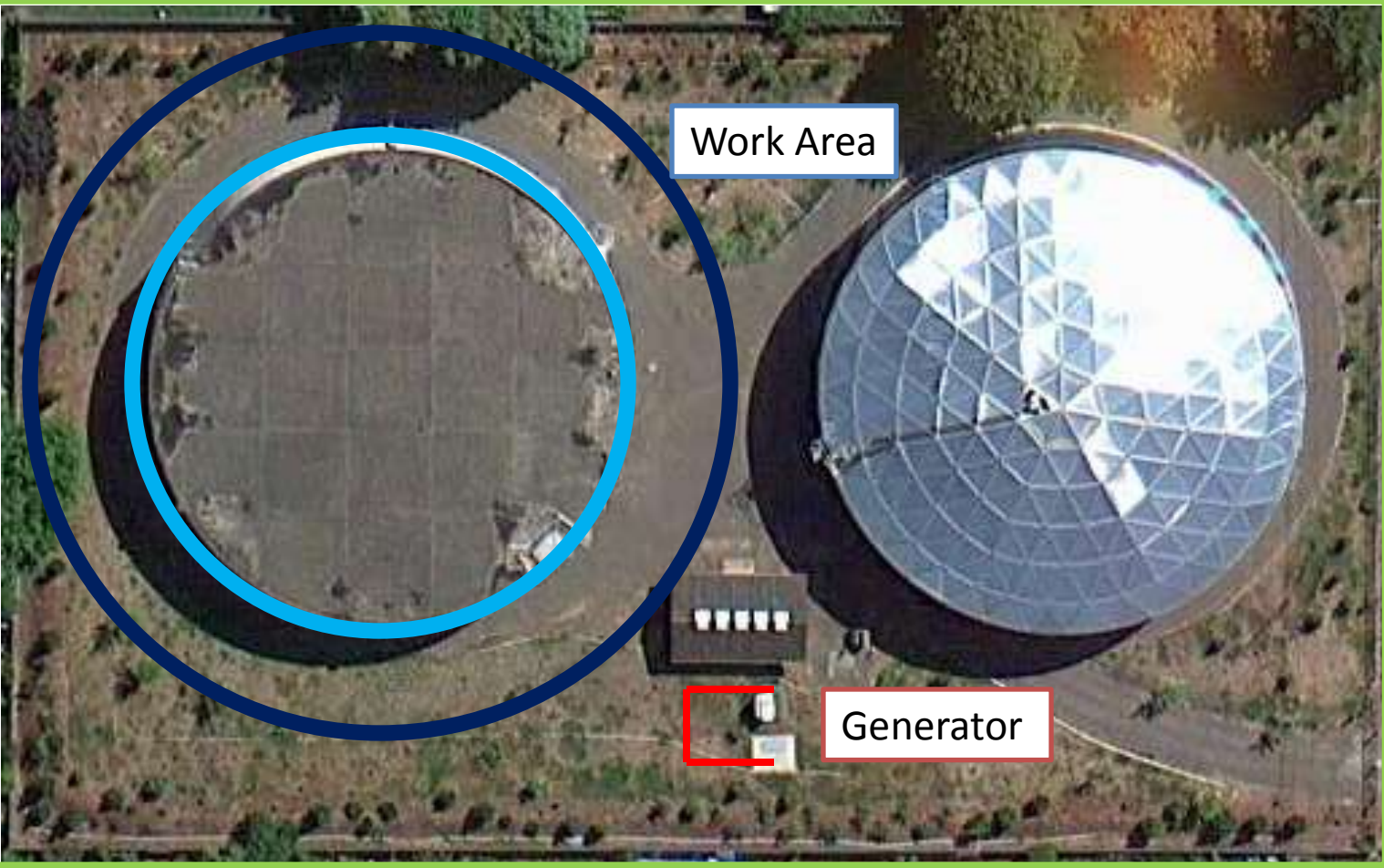
What's Left on the To-Do List?

- Seismically retrofit and paint the tank
- Upgrade roof coating, vents, ladder, downspouts, replace interior piping
- Install semi-enclosed standby generator

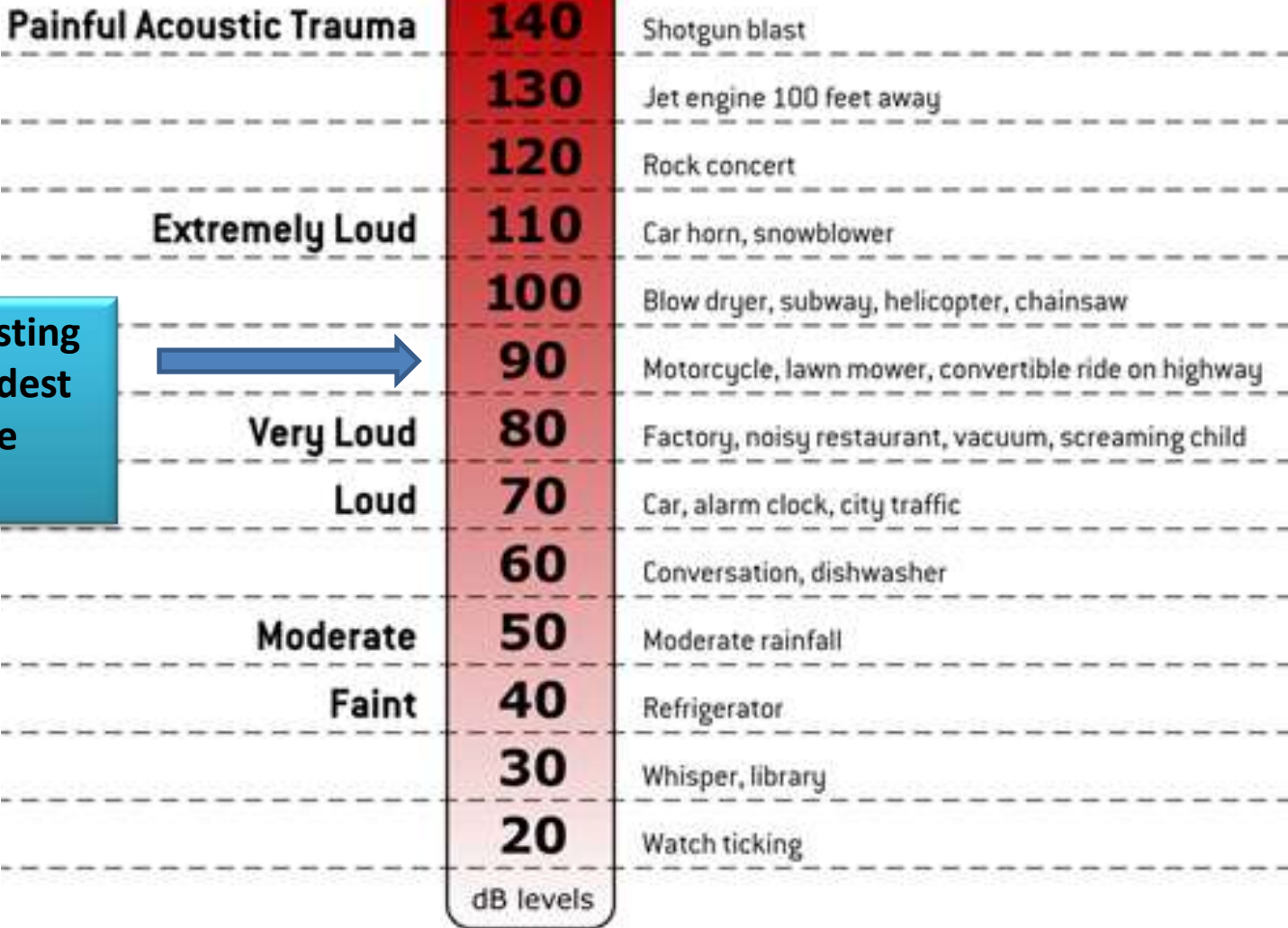
What's Left on the To-Do List?

- Seismically retrofit and paint the tank
 - Dig out around tank
 - Hydroblast the exterior (about 2 days)
 - Wrap the exterior with cable
 - Shotcrete the exterior





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Hydroblasting is the loudest task in the retrofit

- Sign contract with Marion Construction Company (this week or next)
