



RESIDENTIAL HEAT PUMP WATER HEATER REBATE

General Information

HOMES THAT QUALIFY FOR A REBATE

- New Construction Homes qualify for one HPWH per residence.
- Site Built & Manufactured Homes qualify for one HPWH per residence replacing an existing electric water heater.

REBATE AMOUNT

- \$300 for Qualifying any tank size Tier 1.
 - \$500 for Qualifying any tank size Tier 2 – 3.
- *Rebate(s) will not exceed 100% of total heat pump water heater cost (does not cover installation costs)*

INSTALLER REQUIREMENTS

- Your installation contractor must be listed on the hotwatersolutionsnw.org website. If the contractor is not on the list, they must go through the training at:

BEFORE INSTALLATION: PRE-APPROVAL

- Pre-installation approval *is* required to qualify for the rebate but an on-site visit is *not* required prior to installation to qualify for the rebate.
- You or your contractor must submit the HPWH Rebate Application before installation via email dwunder@canbyutility.org or fax to 503-263-8621.
- Required information for pre-approval: Household Information, Installation Information (brand, model, size, installation location, conditioned/unconditioned), 2nd page (name, signature, training location (ex. online video), training date, installer name, installer signature, date).
- The approval process takes approximately one business day.
- An on-site visit is *not* required prior to installation to qualify for the rebate.

AFTER INSTALLATION: FINAL DOCUMENTATION

- You or your contractor must submit a completed HPWH Rebate Application and final invoice

QUALITY ASSURANCE INSPECTION

- A follow-up inspection may be required.

REBATE CHECKS

- You can expect to receive your rebate check 8-10 weeks after submitting the completed rebate application and required final documentation.
