Authorization for Recurring Credit Card Transaction

We are pleased to be able to offer you a new payment option – *Recurring Credit Card Transaction*. You may pay your Utility bill by having the monthly bill amount automatically charged to your credit card.

Recurring Credit Card Transaction may provide you with the following benefits:

- It saves you time in writing a check for payment.
- It saves time in mailing or delivering your payment.
- It means your account will be paid on time even if you're on vacation or out-of-town for an extended time period.

Here's how *Recurring Credit Card Transaction* works:

You will receive your normal bill for your review and records. However, your payment of the bill will be processed by electronically debiting your account **on** or **near** the payment due date. The amount of the withdrawal will appear on your credit card statement. This service is free and optional for Canby Utility customers. To use this service, complete this authorization form and return it to the Customer Service Department.
